## ◀ *What IS PACE®?* ▶

A nursing home is not the only care option for senior citizens who live within the PACE® (Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly) service area. PACE® is a program that fulfills a wide range of healthcare needs of the elderly within the familiarity and comfort of their own homes and community. Through PACE®, teams of healthcare professionals who specialize in working with the senior community help participants and their family members

**make positive healthcare decisions and  
receive the care they deserve.**





## ELIGIBILITY

In order to join the Thome PACE program an individual must:

- Be age 55 or older
- Be certified as meeting the State of Michigan criteria for nursing facility level-of-care
- Live within the Thome PACE service area
- Be able to live safely in the community with the support of Thome PACE

Thome PACE provides an alternative to nursing home care for participants – allowing seniors to remain independent in their own homes and communities. Participants may receive medical and supportive services in our Day Center located in Jackson, Michigan. We also offer a variety of services that can be provided in the comfort of your own home. We have relationships with many specialists and providers in the community to ensure that participants get the care they need.

A participant may be fully liable for the costs of medical services from an out-of-network provider or without prior authorization (except in emergency services).

Thome PACE serves Jackson, Lenawee and Hillsdale counties. Most participants who have both Medicare and Medicaid pay nothing more for PACE® services.
